IN SHORT

The world your students are walking into keeps changing, faster than any syllabus can keep up. So the real question is not whether they pass. It is whether they are ready for the work that exists now, and able to build what does not yet. Will they look for a job, or *make one*? These two days are about answering that, with AI as your partner: sharper thinking for a field that keeps moving, the right way to use AI in your teaching and research, and innovation that solves real problems and makes things people actually use.

§1 Why this, and why now

- 1 The ground keeps shifting. AI is changing what your students need to know, faster than any syllabus can be rewritten.
- 2 Job-ready is just the floor. The real question is whether they can land the work that exists, and create work that does not exist yet. A higher bar, and one you can teach.
- 3 Innovation has to land. Not clever for its own sake, but solving real problems and building things people actually use. Used well, AI makes this part of the teaching, not an afterthought.

§2 What this asks of you

To send out a graduate the world wants, or one who builds their own way, a teacher needs three things. And you can only teach what you can do yourself.

- Teach how to think. So they can decide what is right, even when AI can do the task.
- Teach the right use of AI. So they use it well, and responsibly.
- Help them build. So they can find a job, or create one.

§3 Who it is for

- Lecturers, professors, and faculty across colleges and universities, every discipline, who want to teach and research with AI, not around it.
- Deans, heads of department, and academic leaders who set the standard for their department and want to lead the AI shift, not follow it.
- Research scholars heading into teaching who want to begin their careers already fluent.

Sending a group? Ask about a private cohort for your college. This is hands-on work with your own material, not a shortcut or a template pack.

§4 What the two days include

- Live with the founder on Zoom. Real-time and interactive, never a recorded lecture.
- Hands-on with your own work from the first hour. Your courses, your assessments, your research.
- A rigorous framework for using AI well, built for Indian higher education.
- Beyond the two days. A standing community on AI in education, and a certificate of completion.

§5 The two days

- Day 1 · Foundations. Five hours, live with the founder. Thinking frameworks, hands-on labs, and problem-solving, with open Q&A.
- Day 2 · Mastery. Five hours, live with the founder. Case studies and hands-on practice: using AI in your own work, and readying students to think, use it well, and build. Open Q&A, and continued learning for cohort members.
